### **Preface and Introduction**

I started my collection of Cuban perfin stamps in 2010. Cuba was the focus of my attention for many years thereafter and one will see the extra amount of information on that country in this volume. Because of the U.S. embargo of Cuban products, the market dried up and materials were not offered for sale. In frustration, I expanded to Mexico. Latin America soon followed.

This catalog, I thought, was long neglected. Maybe a paucity in the number of Latin American collectors or a decline in stamp collecting generally was the reason. I thought I could improve the situation by updating the 1992 original work.

Word processing and image processing have improved over the original publication. I can scan images and create patterns which are clearer and straighter than before. No tracings are currently used. Obtaining these better images has been a huge part of my undertaking. Displaying them on clearer illustration pages helps.

The **ABC** classification system has been retained: **A** is used for commercial perfins on postal, airmail, special delivery stamps, etc.; **B** is used for perfins on fiscal stamps; **C** is used for all others: official, philatelic, personal.

Numbering after the initial letter is problematic. There have been so many additions to the original material that there are many entries which, in order to keep them alphabetical, have one and two decimal places after the whole number. People use catalog numbering in their exhibits and collections, so renumbering is mostly out of the question. There have been some numbering changes as listed in Appendix A with the bulk of them because of changes made to Uruguay fiscals which, for some unknown reason, has been added with absolutely no care about alphabetizing them.

Many British colonial postal stamps, inscribed "Postal" and "Revenue" can be found with fiscal cancels: usually straight line or oval purple impressions, ink manuscripts, green crayon marking, etc. Where so noted, perfins on these fiscally used postal stamps will have a **B** classification. Arbitrary decisions had to be made in determining **B** and **C** status since fiscal usage is often a result of official sanction. It is not always clear if the perfined stamp was used for collecting a tax or merely to indicate official (or semi-official) prerogative. A few items have been reclassified to reflect the latest information.

I have introduced a new "design" column in the patterns listings and colored the pattern letters red. This obviates the need from looking back and forth to the illustration page to make certain you are looking at the right pattern.

Obviously, we have a long way to go before having a complete volume. Some patterns are partials or incomplete since they are one of a kind. Dates of usage are particularly incomplete. But I hope I present you with a more usable and enjoyable volume for what, for me, is an enjoyable hobby.

There are new patterns found for Puerto Rico, British Honduras, Guatemala, Cuba, Mexico, Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Peru, Uruguay and other countries. We have found many pattern owners of previously known patterns. Improvements have been made to many footnotes.

It has been a busy time but rewarding to me. I hope you find this revision rewarding and for it to be of help in your collecting.

# **Credits for Help on this Publication**

The largest addition by far is the Chile revenue and punch section which has grown to 46 full pages (23 pattern pages and 23 description pages). I was put in touch with Heinz Junge of Santiago, Chile, who happens to be a collector of Chile revenue stamps and internationally known exhibitor of the same. He had not previously paid much attention to the perfins on his stamps, but once I prodded him to help in this project, he jumped into it with both feet. The resulting collaboration yielded well over 100 new patterns, plus identification of owners of existing patterns, and a new section on Chile cancellation punches. I cannot thank him enough. Other contributors to the Chile project include of Dan Baugher and Patrick Durbano.

Daniel González of La Paz, Bolivia, aided in adding Bolivia to the volume for the first time with seven patterns. Bolivia has no postal patterns and revenue patterns were elusive.

The three Argentine authors of their perfin catalog have helped immensely. I especially thank my friend Juan Pablo Miri who has greatly expanded our knowledge of Argentine patterns and the Bunge y Born, Ltd., complicated series of fifteen perfins.

I happened, quite by accident, to learn of the existence of a large Latin American collection of a deceased member of the Perfins Club and purchased it from his son. I was amazed to see new patterns coming from that collection.

The late Bruce Brunnell helped a lot. In a series of articles in the *Perfins Bulletin* beginning in 2009 he greatly improved on our knowledge of Latin American perfins. The late Rudy Roy helped as well over the years as a contributor and writer on the topic. John Welsch and I have collaborated on Mexico, his strong suit. John Randall contributed to British Colonies. Patrick Durbano was especially valuable in editing and supplementing my materials. Steve Endicott provided the final editing and did a superb job of it.

# **Explanations of Numbering and Abbreviations**

- 1. A decimal in a perfin catalog number indicates a new perfin type. Example: A10.5
- 2. A lowercase letter in place of a decimal indicates a die variety or code hole variation. Example: A10a
- 3. Unless otherwise noted in headnotes or footnotes, dates of usage refer to the issue dates of stamps with the perfin, a cancel date on a stamp, or postmark dates of perfin covers.
- 4. Spanish abbreviations used: S.A. *Sociedad Anónima* (public limited liability company); S.R.L. *Sociedad de responsabilidad limitada* (limited liability company); and Cía, *Compañía* (Company).

Canal Zone – The postage stamps of the Canal Zone from 1904 to 1924 were Panamanian stamps overprinted with "CANAL ZONE". A brief exception to this was in 1904 when U.S. stamps were issued with a "CANAL ZONE / PANAMA" overprint. Then from 1924 to 1933 U.S. stamps made their appearance with "CANAL ZONE" overprints. Canal Zone permanent issue postage stamps appeared in 1928 and were printed until 1978 when the U.S. relinquished its authority over the Zone.

Schwerdt listed five U.S. patterns in the 1992 edition which have been questioned ever since. Collector Bob Szymanski says he has never seen them, nor did Schwerdt according to Szymanski who refers to them as "philatelic follies". Collector Douglas Cutler has verified the existence of J144. They are rare or perhaps unique. Those U.S. patterns which have now been deleted in this edition are: C0005.5, F153, G014, J144 and P174. Recently this author saw the University of Nebraska perfin on Canal Zone stamps offered on eBay. I presume them to be specious. As of now, nothing indicates that any of these stamps ever were in the Canal Zone, much less legitimately used there. If someone ever finds a legitimate, contemporaneous Canal Zone postmark over any one of these perfins on a cover, this decision will be reevaluated.

The official **P** perfin is said to have been made from U.S. perforator **R116** after the two R's were removed from the **RPR** (Panama Railroad Co.) punch.

Puerto Rico – After Spanish rule ended in 1898, beginning in 1900, the postal service of Puerto Rico became assimilated into the U.S. postal system and U.S. stamps were used. U.S. Catalog numbers are in parentheses.

Former patterns A1 (CC) and A2 (CF) reported in 1992 have been eliminated. These were ordered in 1917 from the Cummins Perforator Co. for Guanica Centrale, Guanica, but no examples on or off cover have been reported.

Pattern C1 has been deleted. A pattern (**SCP**) was ordered from Cummins Perforator Co. in 1915 by the Sociedad Co-op de Premios. That pattern is unknown. The *U.S. Catalog* has an illustrated listing (**S086**) for an **SCP**, but it has no user identification, known usage of "1926-34" and a reported postmark of "Pueblo, Colorado". They are not likely to be the same.

Covers with U.S. Patterns **D130** (**Du/PONT**) (DuPont de Nemours Co.) and **G032** (**GA/&Co**) (G. Amsinck & Co) exist with Puerto Rico postmarks. The first (1942) is on a self-addressed stamped envelope sent back to Wilmington, DE. The second (ca. 1912) is a "U.S. Sea Post – Porto Rico" cancel and it was directed to be sent on a particular vessel.





- Jamaica: A1 and A2 are the subject of an article by Thomas Foster in the *British Caribbean Philatelic Journal*, Oct. 1968. A3 has been seen on many postage stamps and a couple of private envelopes mailed 20 years after the issuance of the stamps it bore, but not on commercial envelopes. B3 also appears on a Jamaica Judicial Revenue stamp without any perfs in front of the 6-point star. Patrick Durbano has two A3 bank cancellations and believes this is the original source of the perfin, justifying a "B" classification in addition to the "A" classification.

In 1992, the **DUN** perfin without control holes was separately listed in *The World Perfin Catalog – American Section* as No. "A5a". Since that time, several **DUN** perfins with one control hole have been identified. Based upon the finding of two multiples, each of which had stamps having no control holes and stamps having one control hole, it is now believed that there was but one ten die machine with numerous pin breaks resulting in the all three combinations. Accordingly, the separate listing has been discontinued because pin breaks do not constitute new varieties.



JUAREZ (BA7): Ciudad Juarez produced perfins on *Aduanas*, but under the name of Paso del Norte. When the late Bruce Brunell updated the second edition of this volume in 2009 in the *Perfins Bulletin*, Sep.-Oct. 2009, page 119, he included a partial "..REZ" and labeled it "B26" (using the former numbering system). This author acquired Mr. Brunell's collection. In it he found what appears to be the model for that exemplar, but it is on a 1924 *Renta Interior* revenue stamp, not an *Aduana*. It is therefore believed to be unlikely that "Ciudad Juarez" ever appeared on an *Aduana*.







# BUNGE y BORN, LTD., of ARGENTINA Appendix to Argentina Section

The firm of Bunge y Born had the greatest variety of perfin dies which held a complicated and interesting secret for a long time. A recent acquisition by the author of many multiples in strips and blocks of four, five and six stamps has revealed that with respect to the perfins where the "B" of the "B.B" perfin is six holes tall (as opposed to the others where it is either seven or five holes tall), they come from just two multi-headed dies. The company had fifteen patterns altogether. Eleven of these are of the "six hole tall" variety: one of the dies contained three heads and the other die had eight heads: two rows of four heads each.

In the case of most multi-headed dies, it is usually impossible to tell the difference between one head or pattern and the next. This is not the case with this Bunge y Born series. All eleven heads of the two dies are similar, but distinguishable from all the others.

The first of these dies, the three-headed one, consists of these three patterns: **A16a**, **A16b** and **A16c**. This is how this strip appears on the die:






At left is a strip of four stamps of this threeheaded die series. The reverse row is shown in mirror image for clarity. The red numbers are those of the Argentina catalog.

One sees a nearly complete three pattern series and a greater space before the next series starts (with **A16a**). This occurs when the stamps are inserted into the perforating machine, punched, and then moved in the machine to punch a new set of stamps.

The second of these dies, the eight-headed one, consists of these eight patterns: on the top row A19a, A19b, A19c and A19d and on the bottom row A19e, A19f, A19g and A19h. This is how the two strips appear on the die:





This strip of five stamps illustrates the top row of four heads or patterns of the block of eight heads. The reverse side is shown in mirror image.

Here you see the end of a strip (pattern A19d) and then a slightly larger gap caused by moving the stamps in the perforating machine. Then the series of four patterns commences again with A19a through the rest of the series of four ending with A19d.

This block of four stamps shows the relationship between the two rows of the die. Without fail the pattern **A19c** appears above pattern **A19g**. Pattern **A19d** always appears above **A19h**. Furthermore, the patterns are always the same distance apart laterally (10 mm) and vertically (17 mm). This proves they were all on one die with eight heads punching eight patterns all at once. One can also see the "B" on the far right as a partial pattern of a new series starting over again. The reverse side is a mirror image for clarity.





Finally comes an illustration of the first half of the eight patterns die. Again, the pattern series starts with **A19a** and the second row of punches always begins with **A19e**.

Beginning in 1901, Uruguay's official stamps were, for the most part, but not always, punched with one of six punches. From 1901 thru the 1907 overprinted "OFICIAL" issues, most were punched with the diamond punch, but a few had the crown punch. The 1910 overprints had the crown and tulip punches. Then, in 1911, Uruguay printed a regular official (*i.e.*, not overprinted) stamp and punched it with the arrowhead, star, cross, tulip and crown punches. From 1915 thru 1928 the overprints were punched with star and cross punches. Sometime after 1923 and especially with the 1927 – 1930 issues the overprinting OFICIAL ceased and official stamps were merely regular stamps that had been punched with the star and cross punches. After that, official mail carried regular postage.

#### **APPENDIX A**

### **Catalog Numbering Changes**

Being aware of the user's desire to not have to reorganize a collection just because a new catalog is issued, the editor has tried to retain most of the old catalog numbering. However, changes were made to numbering due to existing errors, changes of classification or the reorganization of catalog sections. Uruguay was way out of whack in the alphabetical listings and was redone entirely. Most deletions and reasons therefore are noted in the footnotes.


Argentina's renumbering was due to a recent discovery that eleven patterns were the result of die variations on two multi-headed dies: one of three heads and one of eight heads. The explanation of the numbering system on page 4 states a lowercase letter after the number indicates a die variation.


